International Day

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday 10th February, Himbleton will be celebrating International Day. During the day, children will be travelling 'Around the World' visiting different countries, learning about different countries and cultures.

Children are invited to come to school dressed in the colours a flag from a country you might be from, might have visited or are interested in. If children would like to wear their country's traditional dress, they are more than welcome to do so instead.

The children will be finding out where in the world the countries visited are on a map, learning greetings in different languages and listening to traditional music. There will be a variety of different activities taking place throughout the day, including arts and crafts, dancing, music and stories from other cultures.

We are inviting parents, carers and children to prepare and bring in food from different countries and cultures to share. Children will be asked, as part of their home learning, to research world cuisine and are encouraged to help in the preparation and labelling of their dish. This food will be available to sample straight after school in the KS2 classroom on International Day.

We ask that all food brought into school has a **clearly labelled ingredients list** and a description of where it is from in the world. **Please note, any gluten free items need to be clearly labelled.**

To participate in the food sampling, we will be asking for donations. All monies raised from this event will go towards a current Pupil Parliament project that the children are working on.
