EMPOWER ACTIVE

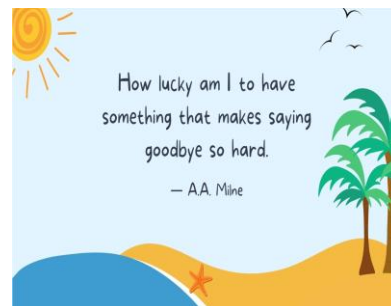
