Performance Times

We ask that, as far as possible, younger siblings are brought to the 2pm performance and would like to reassure you that, due to the fact that it is often past younger children's bedtimes, the attendance of Nursery children at the 6pm performance is entirely optional.

Speaking Parts

We are very proud of Year 2 children who, through being allocated lead roles, speaking parts and lines to learn, are demonstrating our value of courage and look forward to hearing them develop in confidence as they become more familiar with these.
